PLAYER ACTIVITY FEE

An activity fee will be required for the 2022-2023 season to help cover the costs of transportation, hotel rooms, referees, tournament fees, equipment, and other associated expenses. This fee only applies to regular season games. Participation in district, regional and state playoff games may require additional fees to be assessed and collected. (Note: Player fees are not refundable.)

TEAM PLEDGE

I, _____(Player's name), understand that as a member of the Lincoln High School Boys' Soccer Team 2022-2023 program I represent the team, and the school on and off the field of play, and that I am to conduct myself in accord to the privilege granted to me by the coaching staff. Therefore, I hereby pledge:

- 1) to abide by all Team Rules set by the coaches as well as all school rules;
- 2) to do my best in the classroom and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 throughout the soccer season. Failure to do this may result in limited practice and play time, and possible dismissal from the team;
- 3) to respect my coaches and teammates at all times;
- 4) to represent myself, the team, and Lincoln High School with the highest level of integrity, dignity and honor on and off the field, in school and out of school and;
- 5) to always work on staying in shape and ready to contribute toward the team by watching what I eat and drink and continuing to work out daily.

In addition to this, I understand that participation in any of the following activities will result in immediate dismissal from the team:

- a) Possession or consumption of any-tobacco- products;
- b) Possession and/or consumption of illegal drugs or alcohol; and
- c) Participation in any illegal activities, (vandalism, theft, hazing, etc.)

Finally, I also understand that all uniforms and equipment are to be kept in the best possible condition; that all items will be returned at the end of the season; and that lost or purposely damaged items will require reimbursement of the cost of such item(s) to the Lincoln High School Boys' Soccer Team.

2022-2023 VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

All parents are asked to be active participants by volunteering your time! Our boys put in a lot of work before they hit the pitch on game night, but there's also a lot of work going on behind the scenes to ensure that those same boys enjoy a great soccer season. We need your help, and the boys are counting on you to pitch in. There are multiple ways for you to get involved, and many of the volunteer options are a great opportunity for a student to earn service hours. Following are the volunteer opportunities that are available at each home game throughout the season:

- **Concessions:** 2-4 volunteers for JV games and 2-4 volunteers for Varsity games. Varsity parents are strongly encouraged to work JV games and vice versa. That way everyone gets to see their son play.
